Ms. Humeyra Colak has been nominated as a principal finalist for the 2018-2019 Turkish Fulbright Student Program. Subject to successful placement, she is eligible for Fulbright funding up to a maximum amount of \$50,000 which will be renewed for a second year of study, given that the student is in good academic standing, to cover study costs calculated at the Fulbright rate. Calculated study costs will take any university cost-sharing into account, and if the Fulbright calculated study costs are below the maximum grant amount, the finalist will only be eligible for the lesser amount.

The Fulbright Student Program requires all grantees to return to their home countries upon the completion of their academic exchange activities in the United States.
